Iván Rónai studied economics at the Budapest University of Economics and in 1987 at the Library School of Kent State University, Ohio. In the early 1990s he was the director of information services of the Hungarian Parliamentary Library. Under his direction the Library launched a new information service called PRESSDOK, which stands for press documentation and was a database disseminated on floppy disks and also on CD-ROM, containing references to articles published in Hungarian newspapers, weeklies and journals.

Currently he is working for the Hungarian Ministry of Education and Culture as deputy head of the Department of Public Collections. He has been working for the Cultural Ministry for more than ten years. In 1997 he worked out and started to implement the ministry's first telematics development program for museums, libraries and archives.
